The new Northern Counties course proved to be a test of at least 3 essential skills of the fell runner, climbing/descending ability, and speed on the level. Steep climbs to Knott Rigg and Causey Pike, rapid descents from Aitkin Knott and Whiteless Pike, and long ridge runs along Ard Crags and Sail.

The general conclusion seemed to be that it was an enjoyable, dramatic and tough course, worthy of championship status.

The event also enjoyed the introduction of international teams for the first time in a British fell race. Disappointed though we were by the absence of overseas teams (one due to national elections where these things take precedence) the home countries were well represented and Scotland mounted a strong challenge to the English favourites.

Another novel aspect of the event, new to most fell runners, was the B.B.C. filming of the race. This will form the focal point of a half hour documentary to be screened later in June. It will be of great interest to all who took part in the race.
