The Association hopes that all Competitors enjoyed this years event which attracted a record entry of 73. for the Horseshoe Race and 17. for the Crag Fell Race. The latter is limited to the age group 16 to 20 years and we are very pleased to have such a representative entry.

The Horseshoe event was notable in that once again J.Naylor of the Kendal A.C. was the first man home and has again broken his previous record time of 3 hours 35 mins set up in 1971 by returning a time of 3 hours.31 mins. Anything under the 4 hours is exceptional and this year 5 competitors managed to do this. D.G.Weir got second place a thing he seems to be making a habit of and D.A.Cannons third on his first attempt at this event was very good indeed.

We had to make a small diversion in the route of the 'run-in' to avoid the dangerous condition of the river. It is estimated that about 100 yds are added because of this.

A new Trophy this year was the 'Father William Trophy' awarded to the fastest competitor who is over 50. This trophy was presented by D.G.Weir and was won by a competitor who is 66 years old. Need I say who?

Many friends have contributed to the list of prizes and in this connection J.Long, K.Heaton, S.Bradshaw, T.Orr A.Beck, D.Oliver. F.Monkhouse J.Ireland must be mentioned. In addition Messrs Fishers of Keswick and Damart Ltd have provided prizes and the contribution of Messrs Atkinson of Windermere in providing blocks of their Kendal Mint Cakes is a very generous gesture on their part. We would like to thank them all on behalf of the competitors and the Association.

The event could not be run without the freely given help of the many checkers and officials and we would thank in particular the services of Lorna Long who stepped into the breach on one of the long duration check points. ( metaphorically speaking of course) The radio control services were very good this year and the combined efforts of the Wasdale, Millom Penrith and Bolton teams gave a very efficient coverage to the event

Other assistance was given by the Seascale Venture Scout Unit and the Egremont Division of St.John Ambulance Brigade while lurking in the background was the R.A.F. Leeming Mountain Rescue Team who incidentally entered one of their members in the race. Nothing like first hand knowledge (and he finished 21st)

A pleasing ceremony took place at the prize giving when Stan. Bradshaw was presented with a silver salver by J.Naylor. The salver had been provided from subscriptions from his fellow fell runners in the Horseshoe event and members of the C.F.R.A. and was given to mark their appreciation of his sportsmanship and as a token for his 60th year. Mrs Bradshaw was presented with a sheaf of flowers from the C.F.R.A. and kindly consented to present the general prizes to the winning competitors

The novelty prize which is presented by Mrs H.Long was awarded to the competitor who returned the best time having never competed in this event before.

The facilities at the Camp were made available by the Warden J.Long Esq. and we are informed that there is every chance that next year showers will be installed.
