The normally simple but steep ascent/descent of Scafell Pike, via Lingmell nose/col, became a navigation exercise with thick mist above 1000 ft. Leaders at the summit, Jack Maitland and Shaun Livesey, visited it for a second time ten minutes later! No one can have been more surprised than Willy Gaunt, who strolled home in splendid isolation (2 $\frac{1}{2}$ minutes in front of the next man) and enquired how many had finished!! He appears to have been the only one of the leading ten, as they disappeared into the mist, to stay on course.

Despite Jack's wanderings, Pudsey & Bramley won the team race without him with 22 points, ahead of Keswick who had 36 points.

A spot check on the number of F.R.A. members at this race revealed 70% members; 30% non-members - interesting?

This year's course was slightly shorter than previously, due to a different start and finish, so Willie Gaunt holds the new course record.

Next year we plan to hold the Blake Fell race (previously in June) the day after the Scafell Pike race, so you can make a weekend of it. Put it in your diary now. (22/23 Sept.)
