This year represents the 30th anniversary of the first Wasdale run in 1972. In commemoration, you will have also received a medal reflecting this. It was a great pleasure for me as race organiser and to the hardy band of volunteers who manned the checkpoints to see so many of you turn up to bless this classic mountain run with your presence. This to me anyway is the defining fell race on the

calendar. It represents the full day's challenge where gent and lady fell runner pit themselves against some of the most severe and daunting peaks in England, collected together in this most beautiful valley of Wasdale. Just to travel here from 'doon Sooth' is a long enough haul, and the true mountain runner will have invested in other visits to recce the challenging route. You have my respect for the time and effort you have put in to do this and for some of you repeatedly placing this event in your diaries. Also for maintaining your fitness level so you may compete well enough not only to find your way round in inclement conditions but also to beat the last closing time on Gable.

Thanks again to all of you for coming, hope to see you next year. So long as I have the strength I shall be privileged to organise this race for you to enjoy pitting yourselves against these mountains.

Results: Following a clear break by the leading 3 runners right from the first checkpoint, Andrew Schofield won by 6 minutes and was duly awarded the only gold certificate (under 4 hrs). After the group ran pretty much together over the first 5 checkpoints, Andrew broke away decisively climbing from Esk Hause to Scafell Pike, then Jim Davies clinching second from John Hunt on the descent through Lingmell Nose by 27 seconds. The winning V40 was Neil Wrigley from Horwich, 2nd Kendal's Allan Miller and 3rd Bowland's Quentin Harding. The V45 category was led by Rob James from CFR, 2nd Clayton's Richard Bellaries and 3rd CFR's Ian Harland. The V50 winner was Rod Sutcliffe (only contender) from Calder Valley, the V55 by a splendid 12th place performance by Dave Tait from Calder Valley, 2nd Bowland's Yiannis Tridimas, 3rd Bingley's Philip Helliwell. The winning gents team (4 to count) was Bowland, comprising messrs Clive Davis, Quentin Harding, Chris Reade and Lee Warburton.

The ladies winner, with an impressive 19th overall, was Angela Brand-Barker from Keswick, 2nd Liz Cowell also from Keswick and 3rd Jane Meeks, Keswick. These 3 also won the ladies team prize (3 to count). Angela also claimed the LV40 prize and Wendy Dodds the LV50 category. 8 ladies (of whom all finished!) ran from a starting field of 65 There were 54 finishers.

Lastly to my committee members Bob Davis for help with registration, Chris Ellen on the radio net. Radio cover ensures your safety on the fells as all checkpointers relay race numbers to Chris and we can track retired runners and time how long you have been adrift before you get to us at the finish and report in. Many thanks to my partner Helen Lancaster for helping with flagging the valley and baking flapjacks/cake and the buns etc.
