Gary Byers led from the start and gained 3 minutes by Water Crag and nearly 4 minutes at the finish. His time was well down on the race record but was affected by particularly heavy going on the approach to the Pepper Pot.

Stockport won the team prize being the only club to put 4 runners on the fell. This is the first year that CFR have not won the team prize since the race started!

Apologies to the runners who ran astray at the foot of the finish funnel in spite of the flags. This is the second time this has happened and caused a change in the ladies' winning order. Some runners were almost posted as missing at the finish because they arrived across the front of the castle and didn't get a time on our check cards as they

did not use the funnel. We will try even harder with the flags next year!

For the first time the race was held a week ahead of the Ennerdale because the CFRA committee is now so small that it was impossible to manage the two races back to back.

Many thanks to all the helpers on the ground and fell and to Muncaster Estates for generously providing both the prize tokens and the idyllic setting for this lovely race.

Please next year can we have more runners so can each of you spread the word? I cannot imagine why the local club could only manage to field 3 in spite of the Duddon being held only the day before. Obviously we will try to keep these races going but it is not very encouraging to have local runners voting with their fell shoes against this and other CFRA West Cumbrian fell races. Please give us all the support you can both in entries and with the checkpoints etc.
