Its funny how cynical checkpointers can be on the phone when you ring them up and ask can they do the usual stake-out? Its the bit where you reassure them that the weather is guaranteed perfect that sets off the caustic reply... However, I am glad they ignore such blandishments and take up enough gear to enable them to cope with anything from snow to heat-wave, bless them all. Wasdale 2000 suffered a small entry this year as it was sandwiched between the championship races Ennerdale and Kentmere. Such is life. 36 competent souls set off into surprisingly favourable conditions. Race winner Glossopdale's Andy Trigg led from the start and at Greendale had increased his 1 minute lead over Bill Sullivanat at Whin Rigg by a further 3 minutes. From there onwards sustained between 3 and 8 minutes' advantage over the chasing group of V40 winner Bowland's Leigh Warburton, Paul Thompson and Rick Ansell. Leigh and Paul ran pretty much together to the Pike but Leigh's descent to the Nose checkpoint was 6 minutes faster. Will Sullivan had been leading Rick and V45 winner Calder Valley's Dave Hyde to the Pike but had a slow descent allowing both other runners past. Further down the field, V65 winner Clayton's Brian Leathley, at 69 the oldest competitor ever to complete a Wasdale, was running strongly in the group of 4 at the tail end.

The weather had closed in by 15.00hrs and driving rain was the order of the day. However, this did not prevent the good packing of the Clayton team to take the prize with 31 points. On the ground we were concerned for the safety of the 2 runners who were up to 2 hours adrift from their last checkpoint before reporting in but all turned out well. The single lady runner, Clayton's Wendy Dodds ran a marvellous race to come in 14th overall and just ahead of V55 winner Rochdale's Dennis Lucas. If she had come in ahead, Clayton would have claimed her as their 4th counter. Wendy looked so fresh at the finish that you could believe she was ready for a second lap!

I signed as many of the sponsorship forms as I could at the race but there must have been many outstanding. Would you please forward any to me for a signature and remember you don't have to complete the course to gain sponsorship, you can use the number of checkpoints visited, (up to 8 which includes the finish), as a multiplier. In spite of the rain coming through the roof I just managed to sign your certificates and keep them dry!

I am very grateful to all of you for your patience and courtesy in waiting for the delayed prize giving. With runners still adrift out on the course in bad conditions I always try to wait until I have news of their safe descent before doing the honours. Thank you also for all your very kind comments on my humble attempts to provide a snack, because unfortunately at the last minute the Gosforth Ladies couldn't be with us this year. I hope that they can be back again next year to provide the usual goodies.

Also to Brian Clarke for helping with registration, Greendale and doing the Lingmell Nose checkpoint alone.
